Read Heb 11:10, 14—Why Abraham they look forward?

Read 2 Peter 3:13,14—Why did Peter look forward?

**Keep On Being Blessed**—The writer ends by giving a blessing to his readers.

How does he describe God? How does he describe Jesus?

What does He pray that God will do? Why?

How are the final exhortations & greetings a blessing to the readers?
