Growth Assignment—Week #5

Be Careful—Heb 2:1-4

Throughout the Scriptures there are many theological ideas that seem to be in contrast with one another and need to be Biblically balanced in order to properly understand God's truth. One of those contrasts is the idea of the sovereignty of God and the free will of man, especially in the context of salvation. Did God choose you to be saved, or did you choose God to be saved? Do you have the assurance of your salvation, or can you lose your salvation? The answer to these questions is yes! The book of Hebrews seeks to keep this tension in proper balance, especially in Hebrews 2:1-4. We have "such a great salvation" from God, but we also must "pay careful attention" so that we do not drift away! Let's take this week to look at these two important truths in the scripture to be sure that we maintain a Biblical balance.
