Questions To Ask When Facing Conflict:

1. What Do You **Know**?

- Hezekiah Did What Was Right

2 Kings 18:5-7 - ***Hezekiah trusted in the Lord, the God of Israel. There was no one like him among all the kings of Judah, either before him or after him. He held fast to the Lord and did not cease to follow him; he kept the commands the Lord had given Moses. And the Lord was with him; he was successful in whatever he undertook.***

2 Chron 31:20-21 - ***This is what Hezekiah did throughout Judah, doing what was good and right and faithful before the Lord his God. In everything that he undertook in the service of God's temple and in obedience to the law and the commands, he sought his God and worked wholeheartedly. And so he prospered.***

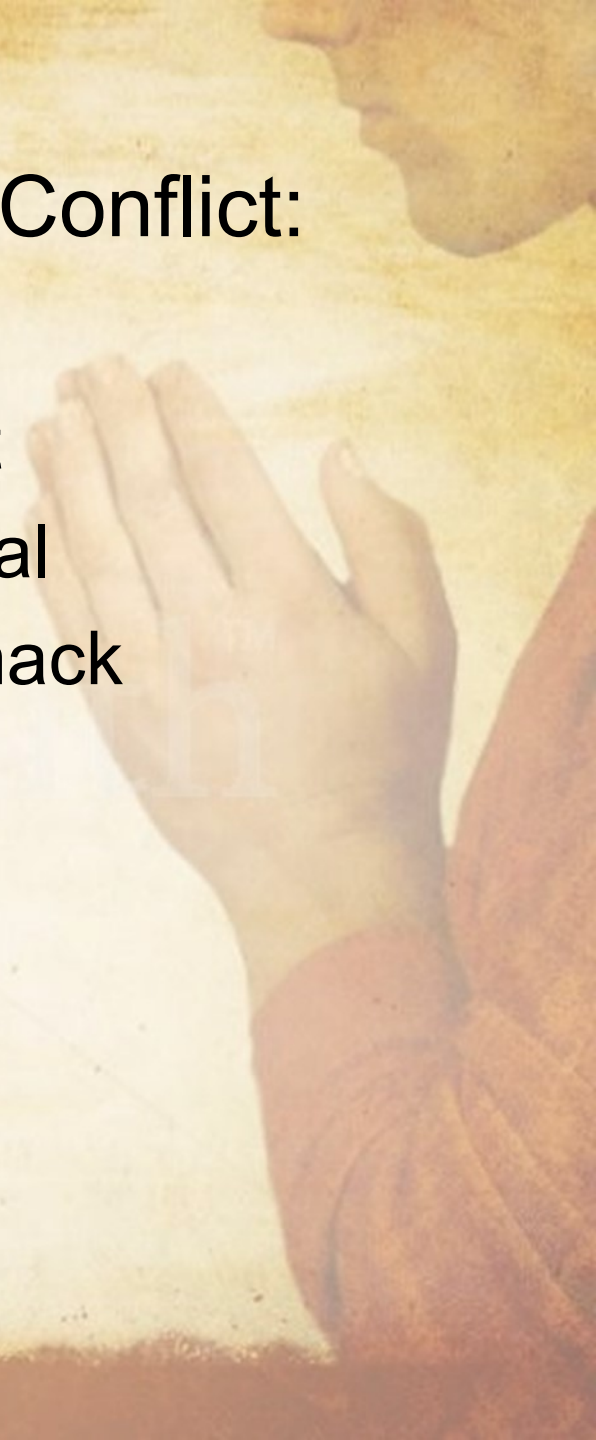

- Field Commander's Talkin' Smack

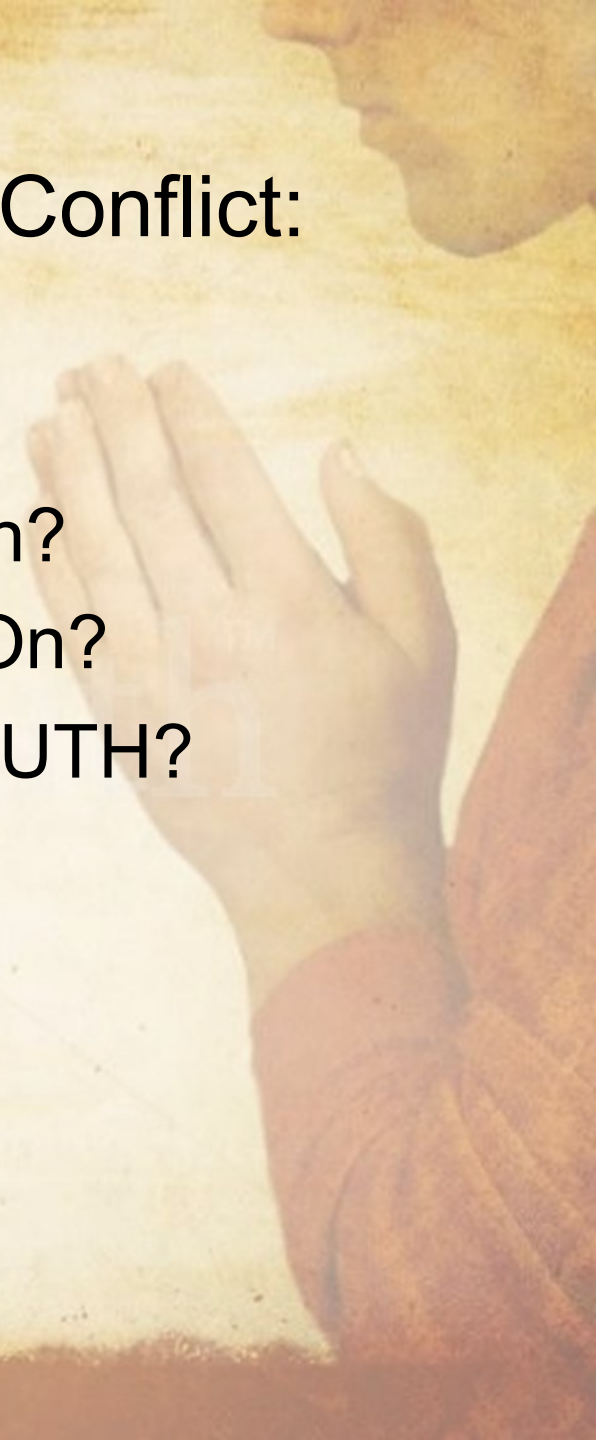

 - 1 Kings 18:21 – But The People Said Nothing
 - Mt 23:63 – But Jesus Remained Silent
 - Is 53:7 – As A Lamb Before Its Shearer

 - **He Planned Ahead** – He Consulted With His Officials
 - **He Prepared Ahead** – He Blocked Springs, Repaired Wall, Built Towers, Made Weapons
 - **He Prompted Ahead** – He Encouraged Them With These Words
 - **He Prayed Ahead** – 37:15 – And Hezekiah Prayed To The Lord
