Growth Assignment—Week #3

Isaiah 6:1-13

This week as we come to Isaiah 6, we come to one of the greatest chapters of the Bible concerning our God and what He is like. In Isaiah 6, the curtain is pulled back and we are given a glimpse of God from the writing and experience of the Prophet Isaiah—He Saw The Lord! So what is it like to see God in all His glory? Isaiah will tell us about his experience. As we study his experience we will learn more about who God is and what it's like to stand in His presence.

Historical Background: Read 2 Chronicles 26:1-23

1. What were the circumstances when Uzziah became king?
2. What were some of the accomplishments of Uzziah?
3. According to vs 5,7 what was the reason for his success?
4. What happen that caused Uzziah's death? (vs 16,19,20)
5. Why did Isaiah say it was in the year that king Uzziah died?

Isaiah's Vision Of God: Is 6:1-4

What do we learn about God from Isaiah's vision of God.
How is God described by Isaiah?

What do we learn about God from this?

Read: Ezekiel 1:1-28—How was Ezekiel's vision like Isaiah's?

Read Revelation 4:1-11—How was John's vision like that of Isaiah and Ezekiel?

The Response: Read the following verses and write down the response that these men had to seeing God.

Isaiah—6:5-7

Ezekiel—Ez 1:28; 3:12-15

John—Rev 1:17

The Sending: In each case God had a calling for them to do. What was the calling of God for each of these men?

Isaiah: 6:8-10

Ezekiel: 2:3-8

John : Rev 1:11,19

The Success: What would be the measure of success for each of these men? What would God do for them or through them?

Isaiah 6:9,10

Ezekiel 2:7-3:11
