This week we will look at a passage in Isaiah that was later quoted by Jesus in His teaching to the Pharisees (Mark 7:6,7). We will look at the passage first from Isaiah, then look at the way Jesus used this passage to speak to the Pharisees.

Isaiah 29:13,14—Read these verses—What is Isaiah saying to the people of Jerusalem?

Read 29:10-12—What do these verses have to say about the people of Jerusalem?

Read Rom 11:7,8—What do these verses say about Is 29:10?

God's Response—How does God respond to those who pay lip service but not heart worship? 29:14—Therefore,

29:15—Woe To Those Who

29:16—Can the pot say. . .?

Look at: Is 45:9— Rom 9:19-21 In the end what is Isaiah saying about the people of Jerusalem?

Jesus Teaching—Jesus uses Isaiah 29:14 to respond to the Pharisees of His time. How does Jesus apply Isaiah to the Pharisees? Mark 7:1-8

The Question: What is the question they ask Jesus? - vs 5

Jesus' Response: vs 8, 9, 13

What does Jesus call them in vs 6?

Read Matt 23:23-27 why does Jesus call them hypocrites?

Do you think this was strong for Jesus?

Jesus Teaching—Read 15:10-11; 16-20 What was Jesus trying to teach the disciples?

How does Jesus' teaching of Isaiah 29:14 to his disciples help us to understand what Isaiah is saying?

How do you think it applies to us today?
