## Week #9—QUESTIONS IN CONFLICT

Isaiah 36:1-37:20

As we come this week to Isaiah 36-37, we come to the historical narrative of the events in the life of King Hezekiah. These events are also recorded in 2 Kings 18 & 2 Chronicles 32. We will look at the reaction of Hezekiah to the threat of attack by Sennacherib this week and the threat of illness next week.

The main question we will be asking is “How do you respond to life threatening situations?”

As Sennacherib threatens to attack Judah and Hezekiah, we want to look at the response of Hezekiah to the threat made by Sennacherib?
