Week #14—The Sacrifice Of God

Isaiah 53

As we come this week to Isaiah 53, we come to one of the most familiar and often quoted chapters from Isaiah. While Isaiah 6 shows the Holiness of God, Isaiah 53 shows the suffering of God for our sins. There is no passage in scripture that more descriptively paints the picture of Jesus' death and substitution for our sins!
